PLAYER DRAFT: All Mosquito, Pee Wee, Bantam and Midget players must attend evaluations.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

REGISTRATION FEES: Regular rates apply for 1st and 2nd child. No charge for 3rd or more children. Rates are payable from oldest to youngest. Player Registration must be paid prior to participation in off-season training programs in SCBA's Indoor Batting Cage. **THERE IS NO ACCESS TO THE BATTING CAGE UNTIL REGISTRATION FEES HAVE BEEN PAID IN FULL.** Registration is available right up to Opening Day, however, you may be placed on a Waiting List if registering after March 1, 2010. **Please register early to avoid disappointment.** Proof of age will be required for all players. We cannot guarantee placement on any one particular team. **Make cheque or money order payable to S.C.B.A.**

NOTE: For Special Circumstances please contact Treasurer to arrange alternate payment schedules.

CONCESSION/VOLUNTEER CHEQUE:

A separate \$100.00 cheque per family (post-dated for June 15, 2010) must be submitted at the time of registration (not applicable to Blastball Division). This cheque will be shredded upon the completion of a mandatory 4 hours of volunteer/concession time. It is your responsibility to contact the parent volunteer coordinator to arrange your volunteer date and time. **If unable to fulfill volunteer duties and want volunteer cheque cashed please mark appropriate box on next page and provide a \$100 cheque dated April 15, 2010 or earlier. Make cheque payable to S.C.B.A.**

UNIFORM DEPOSIT CHEQUE: A separate \$100.00 cheque per player (post-dated for June 15, 2010) **must** be submitted prior to uniform pick-up or a uniform will not be issued. This cheque will be shredded upon receipt of the uniform in clean and good condition at the end of the season. **Regulation helmets are mandatory for all players in our Association (not supplied by SCBA).
